From Lobos M/C

At a recent meeting with Central Oregon OHV Recreation Managers, Lobos reaffirmed their commitment to work as responsible partners in promoting off-road racing in the Millican Valley and East Fort Rock Trail Systems. When promoting an event, a club enters into a contract with the managing agency of the system they will be using. That agreement requires the club to be sure entrants are in compliance with the laws all users must obey while enjoying the OHV trail systems. What this means is that all entrants must have a current OHV tag, a USFS approved spark arrester, and pass a 99db sound test at 20". Casual riders should also be aware that if they are operating a bike above the 99db state level they are subject to receiving a ticket. Expect a stepped up enforcement program in the future.

The Lobos' sound meters have been calibrated and we invite anyone who wants to know if their bike will pass to visit us any Thursday night at our clubhouse. Lobos will not jeopardize their race program by allowing non-complying bikes to participate in our events. If you can't pass the 99db test, STAY HOME.

Lobos are also examining ways to increase safety in the Junior Class. We had an incident at the Fall Classic event where a junior rider got off course and was passed by the sweep. He subsequently got back on course and ran out of gas. To everyone's relief, we found him, but we returned to camp in the dark.

Class I and III operators over 12 must either have a valid driver's license, a permit or be accompanied by a person 18 years or older with a license or permit. Children under 7 cannot operate Class III vehicles. Class III operators between 7 and 12 must have an operator permit AND be accompanied by a person 18 or older who has a license or permit. You should carry your license or permit with you when riding.

Every rider should carry fire-starting materials and be prepared to spend the night in the desert if something unexpected should happen.

Lobos have put a call for an "EMT" that would be able to go to the events in the Bend area. We need an ad in the OMRA newsletter and should imply that we are willing to pay a fee that we can work out. If we cant find anyone, the desert events will be a thing of the past, so the greenies will have won with out firing a shot, if you get the jest. We are trying the Prineville area and Redmond for a few EMT's, but no response yet.

The Lobos appreciate the support that riders have given us in the past and we look forward to seeing everyone again during the 2003 racing season!

From Trailsmen M/C

Here it is the last month of 2002. Trailsmen have been trying to do work in the Tillamook State Forest. We are still working with Oregon Department of Forestry as well as all of the clubs. But government agencies sometimes don't move at all. We still haven't been able to put in any bridges in the forest. We have been waiting for over a year to get ODF to approve the bridge design, but we are still waiting. We are getting ready to do some rocking on the Jordan Creek trail and will be doing some brushing on the Starkey Trail reroute. We were donated five pallets of cinder from Mutual Material in Hillsboro. Thanks to Cindy and Heidi out of the Hillsboro office for all of there help in acquiring the cinder block. Phil Weber of Trailsmen has been in negotiation with Mutual Material to allow this to happen. We would like to say thanks to Phil for having such good skills in negotiations. Department of Forestry has accepted another position from Oregon State Parks. At present there is NO OHV coordinator for the Tillamook State Forest. Thanks!

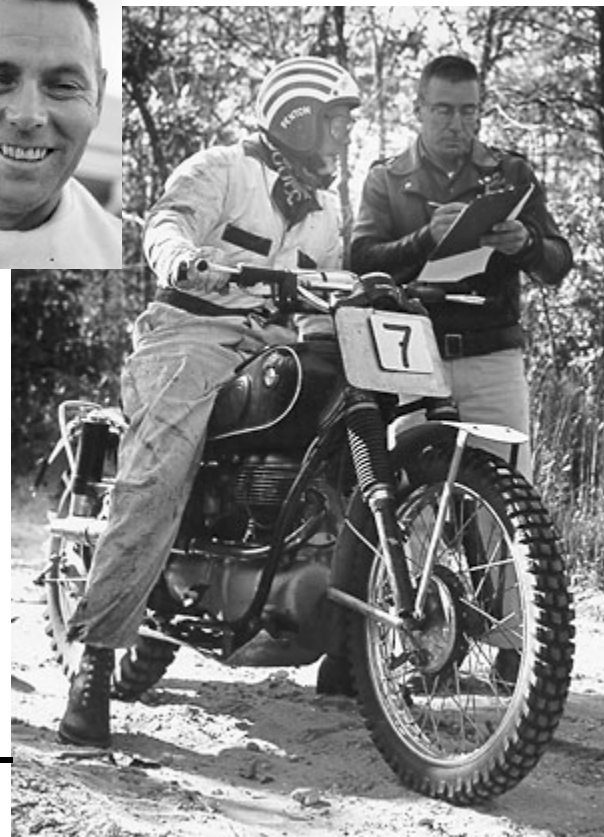

Who is this influential and world-renowned off-road rider?
Here are some hints: (answer on last page)

- Right about the start of WWII, his older brothers had revived their father's dilapidated 1914 Harley-Davidson, which had been long forgotten in the corner of a barn, and this was his first motorcycle.
- In 1958 he broke the New York to Los Angeles record and rode from New York City and set off for California on a BMW R69S outfitted with an oversized gas tank. Fifty-two hours and eleven minutes later, he rolled into Los Angeles.
- He created dirt bike boots, as we know them today, from the old standard work boots people wore when riding.
- In 1960, he won the AMA's Most Popular Rider Award (now called Pro Athlete of the Year).
- In 1967, he was a member of the U.S. International Six Day Trial (now called International Six Day Enduro).
