If you want to express support for ODF's grant to purchase a Single Track ST240 machine, one simple paragraph from an average user/family would be beneficial for them to see. Below are some comments heard from other riders and land managers. You may have additional thoughts, which are welcome. If you agree with some of these comments, please might say so – without just copying them from below, send a your letter to State Parks and the ATV Committee. Since copied letters aren't very meaningful, putting it in your own words is recommended.

"I/my family ride in the TSF (for a long time/years) and I love riding on single track motorcycle trails."

"Dozer-built trails are taking over and eliminating my favorite kind of riding all over the State. They're too fast, too dangerous and not fun enough unless you go fast."

"These larger machines tear up too much ground and remove too many trees."

"I've seen the machine work and it's just what we need."

"It's important to me that it's made in Oregon."

"This is what I think our ATV funds are for."

"My favorite trails could be maintained instead of closed or ruined by large equipment."

"The \$ per mile to build and maintain trails this way will be much lower in the long run."

something more to our sport. Without stealing from the past, I'd like to say we have accomplished one of our many goals and that was to go "back to the future" and bring the state more of what the OMRA started in the early 70's - that is scary to think about since most of us would like to forget the 70's - disco balls and all - though I do see some bikes and gear out there that seem to be trying to bring it all back.

This year's plans are BIG. We expect another record-breaking Annual Awards and Fund-raising Banquet. With your help, a record-breaking membership of up to 1500, gaining on our goal of 3000, over 3000 OMRA event participants, a huge legislative year which began last fall, a fantastic and full poker run schedule, action packed XC/GP schedules with over 26 events, a growing ATV membership and some great dual sport events. We also expect to catch up on last year's OMRA Fund Raising Run numbers and make up the lost legislative funds, so we can stay and weight the battle for our riders.

With that note on volunteers, WE NEED YOU. You do not have to be a board member, show up at every meeting or even be a rider. We need volunteer staff to help us be more organized, more on time, more streamlined and quite frankly, to keep up with all of your needs, and the needs of the sport and our growth to where YOU want us to be for you. From one hour a month, to a few, we just flat out need the resources. This year there are already several people who are stepping up to help us get our electronic scoring program off

the ground - something you want as a whole. We are going to need volunteers to help us get this going and run it. The more we have, the less it will take of your time and commitment. We need people to go to town meetings, committee meetings, event officials, and even finish off 2008 with our great Awards and Fund-raising banquet! Remember you don't need to be an officer or even a director, or on a committee. It does not need to be every time you show up that you're an automatic volunteer. Pick something you can add value to (or help with) and be counted.

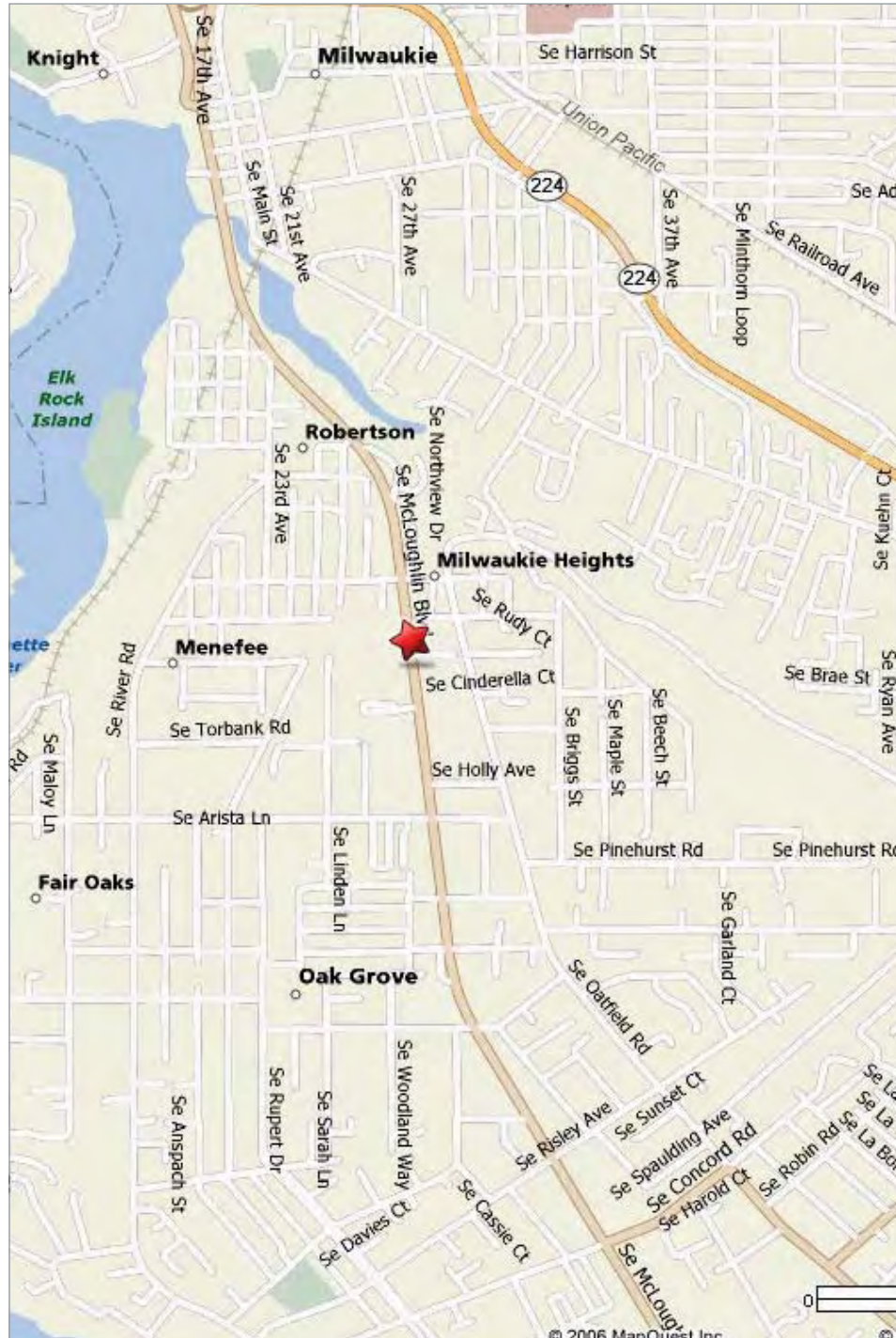
