You're also not a safe rider, according to what I heard last year at the State Capital and others want to make laws to protect you!

Fellow riders and fellow friends of rider's - with the OMRA Membership behind you, the government and those groups (who tirelessly fight to limit and eliminate your access and privilege to ride) will have to count you among those that care, share and take care of our lands and our kids. Be counted among those that ride and vote - if only through the OMRA, so you don't have to!

Listen up members - if you've got friends that are not members simply because they don't race, or they didn't get their membership card fast enough,

OMRA HISTORY

In 1972 there were 6 people that saw a need for a group to stand up for the rights of motorcyclists of all types. It started with a growing need to curb legislation that was looming out of Salem: Mandatory goggles, boots and full length clothes. We rallied our troops and won that battle. The next battle was a need for riding areas throughout Oregon. It started with the Sandy River and after a short time the county agreed to set aside approximately 5 acres. Although these gains may have seemed small, we were gaining a foot hold in the state capital and the name "OMRA" was becoming a common term among politicians.

PLATE COLORS CHANGE IN 2008

In January 2008, the mandatory plate colors for one group of riders will change. The A class plate colors will be blue with white numbers.

Due to mixed signals leading up to this change, riders who have bought blue plates with yellow numbers will not be forced to change to white numbers during the 2008 season.

Below is a list of plate and number colors for the upcoming year:

Class	Level	Plate	Numbers
AA	Mandatory	Red	White
A	Mandatory	Blue	White
B	Optional	Yellow	Black
C	Optional	White	Black

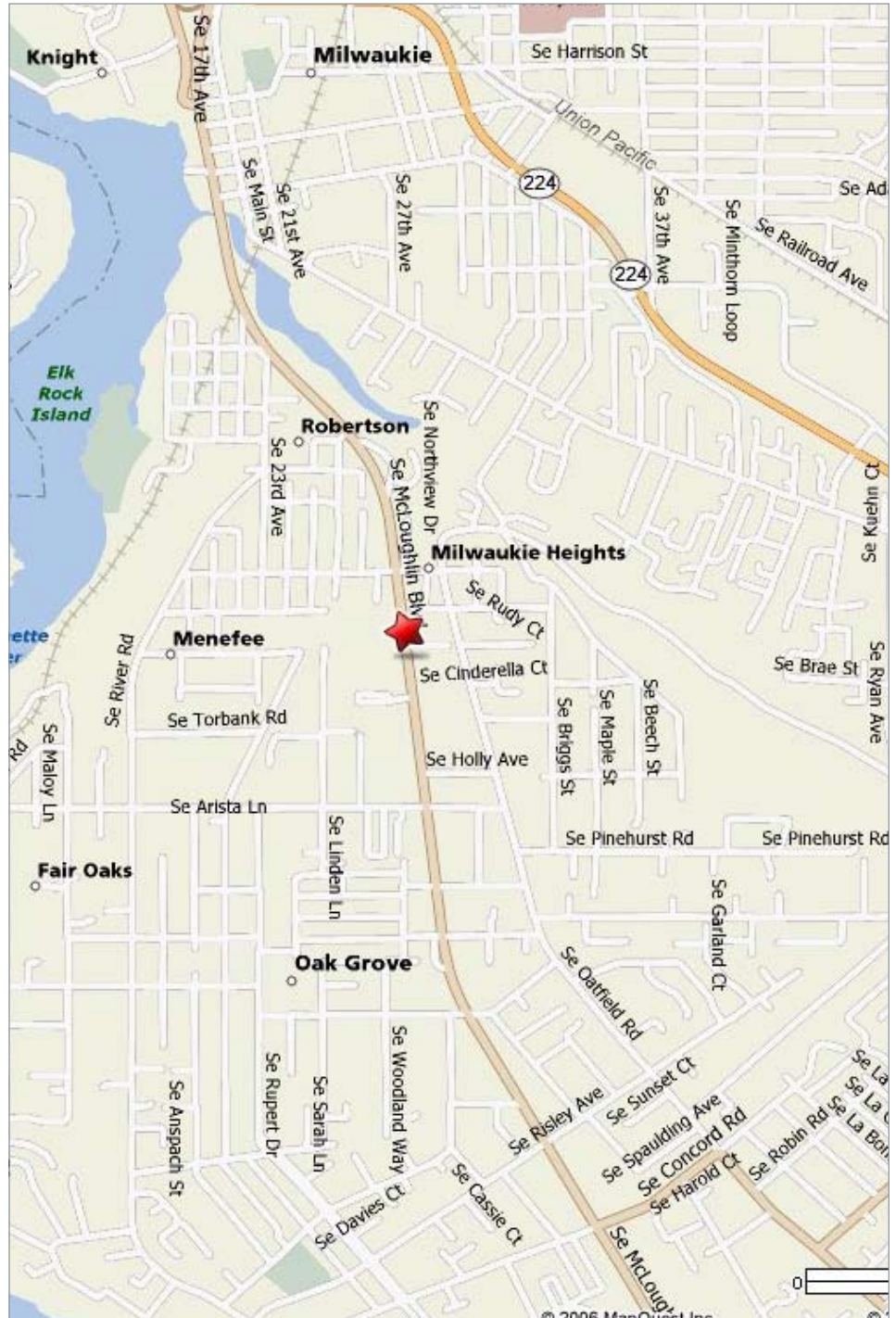
OMRA ANNUAL BANQUET
