In order to avoid being just another couple guys covering motorcycle racing, we decided that our show would revolve entirely around off-road racing, and feature racers who don't necessarily fall in the AA/Pro class category. The fact remains that 90% of the racing community is made up of amateur-level competitors, so we decided when we were covering local series; we would give exposure to everyone. From the AA to Junior classes, we were going to cover it all.

# OMRA Tested



## **Ballistic** - High Tech Battery

Thanks to the evolution of electric start, more and more bikes these days are requiring batteries. Myself, having owned various electric start KTM 's since 2000, have had the opportunity to try a few different types. Last October, I was in MotoSport Hillsboro picking up a few parts in preparation for the up coming 24hr race and a fresh battery was on my list. As many of you know, the 24hr event demands a lot from your battery in keeping your trusty steed lit up all night long. I asked the parts manager what was the best battery available and he handed me the Ballistic. My first impression of the battery was one of amazement as I felt how light it was, weighing in at just .885lb. That is great but I needed one that would stand up to the demands of a 24hr event. Ryan assured me this battery was up to the task. I took him at his word and installed EVO2 4 Cell battery. The battery slipped right in and fit just as good as the stocker. Preparing for the 24hr, I tested the battery by running my lighting system for a couple of 4 hour night rides sessions and had no problems with lighting or the bike starting. This battery actually has more cranking amps, 135CCA, and started my 2010 KTM-300 much better than the stock battery as well. The true test was the 24hr. I am one of the night guys on our AA team and run a Trail Tech 3 bulb Extreme Hid head light and a MR-16 helmet light all pulling amps off the one battery. The Ballistic held true to Ryan 's recommendation. It worked flawlessly. Never ran low on amps or blinked out over the entire event.

Ballistic performance batteries are

If you are looking to shave a few pounds off your machine and have a true maintenance free battery that requires no trickle charging, then this is it. The Ballistic EVO2 4 Cell battery retails for \$99.95, a little more pricey than a standard lead battery but you won 't have to replace it every year either, so in the long run you are way ahead.

MotoSport Hillsboro also offers OMRA members a %10 discount, saving you \$10.00 off the cost of your battery.

The next step was finding a place to film, and figure out how we were going to edit the footage. Enter Phil Crane. Phil is a longtime motorcycle enthusiast and ETRA member from Eugene whose passion lies behind the lens of a video camera. If you've seen video coverage of the Funky Chicken National Hare Scrambles, it's more than likely Phil shot and edited it. Because Don, Phil and myself all live in the Eugene area, it was a perfect fit for us to use his house as the set and editing headquarters for the show, and being able to dedicate an entire room of his house to be the permanent set has been a huge asset.

When the time came to post our first episode online, none of us really knew what to expect. Neither Don nor I had much experience being on camera, and even with Phil's great editing experience, we didn't quite know how it would turn out. At first, views were trickling in from message boards where Don and I had posted links, but two days later, the number of views spiked to nearly two thousand. Racer X found out about the show after Southern Oregon racer Devin Watson sent them the link, and when they posted it on their industry news section of their website, the hits were rolling in. Shortly thereafter, FLY Racing became the first official sponsor of the show, and other possibilities opened up. The credibility of having FLY Racing as the show's main sponsor opened doors to interviews with full fledged professional racers such as Jason Raines, Chris Bach, Ian Blythe and Robert Underwood, with more big name riders in the works. As of now, we've produced three episodes, and are

working on three more we filmed last week.
