This is the last newsletter for the 2001 race season. Hope you had much fun as I did? Here are some updates for next year's riding [rule changes]. 1. Team races are 15 instead of 35 points. 2. Required:: 3 number plates with numbers and letters for I.S.D.E., cross-country & grand prix. 3. Have an ambulance or EMT on site. 4. Change OMRA schedule meeting time from 7:30 to 7:00. 5. Change throw outs from 1 in 5 to 1 in 8 races. There was also a motion to do away with 4-stroke class! It did not go through the proper steps so it will not go into effect this year.

The motion will be resubmitted next year. Please let us know about this or any other questions you may have. When it comes to your points or something about the race that was wrong or good, email me or one of the officers. The new calendar will be out shortly and looks like lots more racing to do. Remember you need your series number & class letter on all 3 number plates [mandatory], also use your color bar to show your OMRA Points rider and proud of it. Race promoters remember to make your results readable, as it has to be put in to the computer by someone else. Promoters and clubs please follow OMRA rules for putting on an event. This was done for promoting off-road racing. We are sorry to say that if the promoters and clubs can't follow the rules then their upcoming event will not be sanctioned by OMRA. - **Oregon Department of Forestry** is looking for clubs or individuals to adopt trails in the Tillamook State Forest. Requirements to adopt a trail are that you must ride the trail 3 to 4 times a year, give an update to ODF, and be able to do light maintenance (cleaning culverts, brushing and filling in ruts). Heavy maintenance would be done with larger work parties or ODF staff. In return ODF will place your name on the trail. - **No ISDE Series for 2002:** There was only one scheduled ISDE originally for 2002 (The Devil's Head), but since that was the only one (Lobos dropped theirs too), the Mt. Scotters decided to change it to a CC event. This means no more ISDEs period. This is too bad, brings and end to an era and will be sorely missed. Why are there no more ISDEs? Clubs site that it took too much manpower and too much work to host one, plus MXer types didn't understand how they worked (and thought it took too much thinking?). This is sad indeed, since not everyone prefers a freeway for a competition course. If you still want to race an event more on the technical and challenging side, you can still ride the timekeeper enduro series in Washington, plus they generally have a couple ISDEs up there too.
- **Team Challenge 2002 entries:** Teams entered will compete regardless of class (amateur/expert/age group/bike size), team members points will be added together at the end of the season to determine a champion. Teams will consist of three permanent members. Each member must compete in at least 50% of the events scheduled for the team to be eligible for a year-end trophy. Yes, worker points do apply. Fee: \$10 per series, per person.

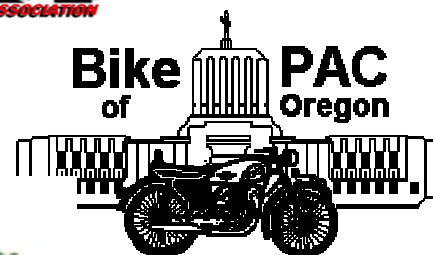
