Temporary Applegate Trail Closures

Fellow Trail Riders, October 3 – Some of the trails in the Upper Nestucca OHV Trail System have undergone trail rehabilitation and drainage work. The project is partly funded and in cooperation with the Oregon ATV Funding Committee. USFS, BLM, and Applegate Rough Riders conducted trail work. While some of these trails have been closed for the winter, others are open for riding. A decision has been made to TEMPORARILY CLOSE for this winter certain trails upon which trail work was performed. This closure will best allow trail tread and water diversions to "settle in", thereby protecting our investment of time, energy, and dollars. PLEASE RESPECT THESE CLOSURES. Signs are posted at each trail entrance. They are also blocked with small logs as an additional deterrent. Your cooperation is requested to not ride the trails and advise others you may see attempting to do so. (Since the trails will be tested, evaluated and monitored during the winter, it is possible you may see quad tracks occasionally on some of the trails, but the trails shall remain closed until announced via this email list and announcements next year.) YOU SHOULD OBTAIN A MAP AND PRE-LOCATE THESE TRAILS ON IT. This will allow you to better plan where to "stage" and ride for the day. The following list shows where major work has been accomplished. Further spot work continues throughout the area by the ARR MC which may affect trail access.

On any of the trails where work was accomplished, the trail appearance has changed from your last visit. Most all "water bars" have small logs across their entrance but still may appear to be a trail - which ends abruptly. Ride cautiously across new water diversions.

My ISDE Vacation

In August 2001 I went to France to help my son Derek and my nephew Jeremy Puma compete in the International Six Days Enduro as part of the USA Team.

It all started in May when we went to the Two Day Qualifier in Idaho. The boys had good rides and we found out in June that they both qualified. We only had about ten days to get the bikes ready, crated, and to the Bay Area for shipment to France. How do you get a bike ready for six days in a row of brutal racing? Start by replacing chains, sprockets, wheel bearings, brake pads, brake rotors, fork seals, and suspension bearings. Then get the headlight and tail light working, and don't forget to install a brake light switch. Grease the steering head and swing arm. Repack silencer, tighten spokes, new grips, new hand guards and so on. Now buy spares of anything that might wear out or break. Take the bike back apart and put it in the crate.

We got to Brive, France on Wednesday. The bikes had to be impounded on Saturday afternoon. The container with Team USA's motorcycles and supplies did not arrive until early Saturday morning. Stressful, but we made it.

Saturday night was opening ceremonies. All the teams from about 40 countries marched into the stadium while dancers did numbers in skimpy costumes to music from each country. Fireworks shot off, freestyle motorcycles flew through the air while riders did their contortions, and the announcers said things in French that had the crowd on their feet and cheering.

Monday morning was warm. The boys were wearing full-vented gear when they got the bikes out of impound at about 8 AM. Ten minutes later

they started out on the 195-mile day 1 course. The French countryside is beautiful. Every village is made up of old stone houses with slate roofs and neat stone fences and flowers in the flower boxes. There are ancient castles, sidewalk cafes, and bridges built by the Romans in 100 AD. The country roads are narrow and with racers, chase riders, pit crews, and lots of spectators all going different directions it got pretty scary. It got into the high 90s as the riders did their second loop on the course. Lots of rocks, some dust and a fairly fast time schedule had most of the riders coming into the check points with five to seven minutes to spare. I was working at one of the seven checkpoints. We would make sure the USA riders were getting plenty to eat and drink, help look over the bikes for problems, hand them tools and supplies, clean goggles, wipe faces, give encouragement, and watch the clock so they got through the check on time. One of the three women on the Team crashed and was taken to the hospital with internal injuries. About 4 o'clock the riders were coming back to the start-finish area where they had about 15 minutes to work on the bikes. It was hot. The poor guys were worn out, dripping with sweat, and covered with dirt, and they still had to change tires and air filters. Since it was our first time we were not prepared for the intensity and confusion of the work area, but the boys managed to change rear tires. I was there to get their parts ready and hand them tools, but only the riders can touch the bikes.

Day two was hot and humid. They rode the same course again and it was very rough from the 600 riders doing two loops the day before. Each day there are five or six special tests, which are timed sections that add points to your score. It's very important to go fast in the specials. The Europeans like to lay out the tests in grassy fields, which is different than the American tests, so we usually don't do as well. The boys are tired, but doing OK. Jeremy is a little bummed because he lost some points for getting to a check late.

Day three was a new course about 175 miles long. I had to get up at 5:30 again to get out to the check before the first rider. The boys were getting very sore. Advil helped. They taped their hands every day, but still got some blisters. Their butts were sore, too.

Day four. It rained through the night and things changed. It cooled a little and was partly cloudy with a few showers. The USA riders were all still going. The course was muddy but not horrible. Brain fade was setting in on the boys and they made little stupid mistakes.

Day five. It rained all night and until about 11 AM. It was very muddy and there were a couple bottlenecks and slippery rock sections that had the riders struggling to stay on time. The boys were getting used to riding, weren't sore anymore and were having fun. Derek's carb vent hoses got plugged with mud and he dropped a few route points fixing it. Jeremy crashed hard and cut his eyebrow and got stitches from the team doctor at the finish area. Today was the toughest course with trials style riding through gnarly boulder fields. A couple US riders had bike problems and DNF'd.

Day Six was a 50-mile course leading to the final motocross test. 16,000 spectators lined the fences of the mile long track, many of them blowing horns and waving flags. Derek had a very good start in his moto. He was in 3rd going into the second corner where he slid out in front of the pack. The 37 riders that were behind him piled into him leaving him with the wind knocked out and in last place. Watching him rail from the back all the way into 8th place in 6 laps was very impressive. Jeremy also had a good moto. He looked a little nervous at first but smoothed out and picked off riders until a flat tire hampered his drive.

Derek and Jeremy both got silver medals. Also from Oregon, Bill Rush, got a silver. Oregon rider John Yates is my hero, he crashed on day three and cut his knee wide open. He got it stitched up and finished the whole thing only to DNF because he missed a check. The six man USA Trophy Team got sixth place, which is pretty good. The French Team won the World Trophy. The USA Junior Team (riders under 23 years old) got 11th place. Next year the ISDE is in the Czech Republic and both boys want to do it again.
