As of last newsletter I received some responses regarding clubs and promoters not following OMRA rules. The general consensus is that you, the riders, want and feel quality events should be held in Oregon. Clubs and promoters: you need to understand that the reason you are putting on events is to keep the sport alive that you say you love. To keep the sport alive and healthy is to have rules that not only protect the rider, but the clubs and promoters. Two years were spent into

development of the latest OMRA rules, unfortunately with little comments from clubs, promoters and riders. OMRA rules were developed to help clubs/promoters to put on quality events. Those few of you who follow OMRA rules, I would like to personally thank you for a job well done.

Clubs and promoters: you need to understand that when you make the decision to put on an event, that some courses have become almost impassable by the novice rider. The course needs to be marked for sensibility for the average rider. Having your course 100 miles with intermediate trails will tire most riders out, but will allow them to get back to the start. By having a difficult 100 miles, your sweep will be spending hours bringing riders back. And those same riders might not return the following year for your event.

Keep me informed if you have any comments or concerns and I will see what I can do.

Words of wisdom from Rick "Super Hunky" Sieman: ✍

DON'T LEND ANY TOOLS OR RIDING GEAR TO ANYBODY. Lending this stuff is simply a method of giving it away. When's the last time your can of chain lube came back to you feeling nice and full after you lent it out? I rest my case.

HOW TO KEEP YOUR NEW HELMET FLAWLESS. Don't ever take it out of the box.
