Dual-European Scrambles July 17-18

There was a new format of racing introduced to Oregonians. With the heat of Summer and usually high humidity during this time frame, Trailsmen M/C held a Dual-European Scramble that consisted of two different loops, loop A and loop B. The class the rider signed up for determined which loop and at what time they would ride. Each race lasted 1.5 hours for each class.

The weather was perfect for the 139 racers that came out to ride. The signup went smooth, riders could sign up the day before the first race and throughout the weekend to eliminate long lines. Loop A was 15 miles in length using very little roads, but several places to pass. There was a 3.8 mile trail that had not been used for over two years (Duane's Trail). There were four bridges that were put in place, along with removing several downed trees. The course started tight, going up Stick-In-The-Nose Trail and then opened up on top to allow for passing in several areas. Duane's Trail is a long, gradual downhill with tight sections. The course opened back up once the racers got down the hill and on to the scenic Spaur Creek Trail, which is a

fast and wide section of the course, which took the riders back to the start/finish area. The amateurs raced loop A on Saturday, which they averaged two loops. The experts generally got in three loops on Sunday.

Loop B was a shorter loop, approximately 8 miles long. It started out with about 4.5 miles of road rage racing before hitting the tighter section of the race course. Some of the course was old trail that had not been used for over five years. Toward the end of the course was the Marvelous Mainline Downhill. This allowed for new challenges for a good portion of the amateur and sportsmen riders. There was a small slide for life downhill to a temporary bridge crossing, which allowed access to the start/finish line a short distance away. The amateurs completed the race in an average of three loops on Sunday, and the experts went around four times Saturday.

Overall, the riders really seemed to enjoy the format, which allowed good racing without bottlenecks, and yet they didn't feel

so whipped from riding on Saturday that they couldn't be competitive on Sunday. Several riders rode more than one class in a day. They rode with a pie plate number just to see how they would match up in other classes. Trophies were handed out to third place in every class both days.

Trailsmen would like to thank the riders for coming out and hope they enjoyed themselves. We appreciated the cooperation with parking in the designated areas and keeping the forest picked up during and after the event.

COALITION FEARS CLINTON'S DIRECTIVE MAY CLOSE AN ADDITIONAL 33-51 MILLION ACRES OF FOREST SERVICE LANDS TO MOTORIZED RECREATION

POCATELLO, ID -- As president Clinton prepares to announce his proposed directive for roads and roadless areas in National Forest System Lands, the Blue Ribbon Coalition (BRC) feels the administration will offer a program that may functionally ban the use of jeeps, sport utility vehicles, off-road motorcycles, snowmobiles, and all-terrain vehicles on 33 - 51 million acres of public lands.

For many years, green preservationist groups have advocated banning most forms of traditional multiple-use of public lands including logging, grazing, mining, and off-highway vehicles (OHVs). Many organized OHV groups work hard to promote responsible use of public lands and often donate thousands of hours of volunteer labor to protect natural resources. It appears that these efforts have gone unnoticed and unappreciated by green elites who feel they alone should decide who uses our public forest lands.

According to Don Amador, the western regional representative for the BRC, "Our organization has endeavored to work with this administration and the Forest Service to find a balance in the land-use equation, but it appears that president Clinton will choose to weigh in on the side of radical green groups and support their land lock-up agenda."

"Just as millions of Americans are rediscovering their forests using various forms of recreation, it concerns us that Clinton's proposed directive could effectively close over 300,000 miles of legal forest roads and designated trail systems. Telling the people that they are not welcome in their forests is a message that most assuredly will not sit well with average citizens who like to camp, hunt, fish, use OHVs, and drive for pleasure," Amador concludes.

The Blue Ribbon Coalition is a national non-profit 501 (c) (3) advocacy group that champions responsible multiple-use of public and private lands. It represents over 550 businesses and organizations with 600,000 members.
